Important information in case of a positive test result:

- **You are obliged to go into domestic isolation immediately (seclusion). Likewise, the members of your household must seclude themselves immediately.** Do not leave your home or accommodation except in medical or other emergencies. You are obliged to avoid contact with other persons.
- **First contact the health office by telephone.** The health office will order isolation with a set of rules of conduct and hygiene measures.
- **First talk to your doctor by telephone** about further measures for yourself and your contacts. **If symptoms occur, seek medical advice immediately.**
- If not already done: Have a **PCR test done to confirm suspected** infection with SARS-CoV 2. Contact your doctor or a testing centre (available via telephone 116117).
- Inform **your employer by telephone or electronically that you are legally obliged to secede after learning of the test result, irrespective of your obligations under labour law.**
- **Be sure to observe the quarantine rules – AHA+L rules!**
Follow the most important rules of behaviour and hygiene to protect your household members from infection:
 - **Keep your distance** (stay in separate rooms if possible), no direct contact with risk groups
 - **Hygiene** (application of coughing and sneezing rules, regular hand washing),
 - **Wear masks in everyday life:** Wear suitable medical protective masks (surgical masks or FFP2 masks)
 - **Regular airing.**
- **Inform all your contacts of the past 14 days about your possible infection.** It is recommended to write down your contacts
- **Domestic segregation ends**
 - If the subsequent PCR test after the positive antigen rapid test should be negative and you have reported this result to the health authority
 - the duty is officially waived, shortened or otherwise modified
 - after the expiry of 14 days, provided that the health authority has not notified the person liable to segregation of a decision before that time
